- 3. Mr. Singh and Mr. Douglas want to open up a DJ service together. They are both prepared to invest \$5000 in this new venture. Write a brief paragraph answering the following questions. Explain the reasons for your answers.
- a) Would it be to their advantage to form a partnership or to each form a sole proprietorship offering the same service?
- b) What are the factors they should consider before they decide?
- 4. Work with a partner. Select a business that you would both be interested in starting up. Then brainstorm some of the issues you would need to resolve to start and run this type of business. Decide whether it would be better for you to own this business as partners, sole proprietors or a corporation. Report your decision and the reasons for your decision.
