- Your introduction should be approximately 5 to 8 seconds
- Practice an introduction that grabs the interest of your audience
- Avoid such phrases as my topic is or I will be talking about
- Be thoughtful but creative
- You will have approximately 20 seconds to prepare for your impromptu. Write your
 name and initial on the board. When you turn to face the class have three key words in
 your mind

Body

- Remember to keep the two or three key words in your mind
- Each point should be approximately 20 seconds in length

Conclusion

- The conclusion will include your final thoughts on the topic
- Avoid such phrases as, I will conclude or in conclusion

Suggestions:

- Practice, Practice and practice some more
- I will discuss strategies to help you be aware of the passage of time
