# Teacher for a Day

## The Task

Imagine that for one day you may change places with any one of your teachers. Compose a one page report explaining how you would run the classroom using the guidelines below for your paragraphs.

## Guidelines

Your report must contain the following sections:

Section One - Tell the grade and subject you would like to teacher, and WHY, it can be at any level.

<u>Section Two</u> – Describe what your classroom would look like, e.g. Bulletin boards, desks, posters, computers, equipment, etc. If your main classroom is the gym, describe the health room and any other locations you may be using.

<u>Section Three</u> – Explain what RULES you would have in your classroom and how you would keep good discipline (no violence/inappropriate remarks allowed, or you will receive a mark of 0 for the entire assignment) **Look at specifications below** – **this section will be a table**.

<u>Section Four</u> – Explain some teaching methods. Would you have the students writing notes, watching movies, playing on the computer? What would you do and why?

<u>Section Five</u> – Explain what characteristics would make you a good teacher, what things you would like to try with your class and what your goals as a teacher would be. If you feel you don't have any characteristics that would make you a good teacher, state what characteristics you would *need* to have.

### Make sure to follow include the following specifications:

- Create a title at the top of the page. It must be centered and underlined.
- Add a page border to the assignment.
- Sections One and Two must be paragraphs with a minimum of five sentences each.
- For the first sentence in Section One use 'drop-caps' on the first-letter.
- Section Two should be right-aligned
- Section Three should be a table with 2 columns and 6 rows. The first row should title the columns.
- From The titles should be 'Rule Broken' and 'Consequence'. Add a column on the left with vertical text saying 'Classroom Rules' The titles should be shaded grey.

- Section Four should be a bulleted list with the teaching method as the main bullet and the sub bullet should be why you would do it
  - £ EG: Movies
    - To give students a break
    - Writing Notes
      - So students have something to study
- Section Five should use 2 different fonts and be a paragraph with a minimum of four sentences. It should be center-aligned
- Your report must be a minimum of 300 words.
- Your report must have an 'art' page border
- You must use complete sentences. Remember to use spell/grammar check.
- Insert a graphic into your document.
- Put your name in the header
- Put the assignment name in the footer.
- Spell check your assignment
- Submit via google classrooms
- For If you do not know how to do something in word google it prior to asking for help
